Project Highlights

Gareth's experience includes:

- Representing four of 41 defendants in a US\$874 million High Court claim brought by the Kuwaiti Pension Fund, which alleges losses for unlawful and unauthorised secret commissions across three decades, with substantial consideration of Kuwaiti, Swiss and English Law.
- Representing a high net worth individual and related entities in a multi-jurisdictional dispute with a private investment bank involving investments of over US\$500 million. Including in respect of:
